

Francesco Marchioro (Padova-Bolzano)

Essayist, historian and expert on psychoanalysis.

He is editor and translator into Italian:

He has produced (1989) as film-maker the film “*Freud's routes*” (together with L. Giudiceandrea, director), by Rai Bolzano.

He founded (1996) psychoanalytic seminars „*Freudian Week*“ in Ritten- Bolzano (1996). He supervised the training courses “*Ethno-therapy and Cultures*” (Bolzano 2004-2006). He founded and directed the „*Ethno-counselling- Team*“ (Bolzano 2005-2008).

He has founded (2006) the “*Freud- Promenade*,” a Freud's Walk on Renon (Bolzano), together with the Renon Council, the Renon Tourist association and the Imago- Research on applied Psychoanalysis- Association. www.freudpromenade.it

He co-founded (2010), together with friends, the “*Academy of Silence*” at the Free University for Autobiography of Anghiari (Arezzo, Tuscany).

As curator he organized the exhibition “*Divine madness. Freud the archaeologist*” at the municipal Gallery of Bolzano (2 December 2011 – 29 January 2012); in cooperation with the London-Freud-Museum. As part-time reporter he contributes to newspapers (Corriere della Sera, Alto Adige) and magazines (Psicologia Contemporanea).
